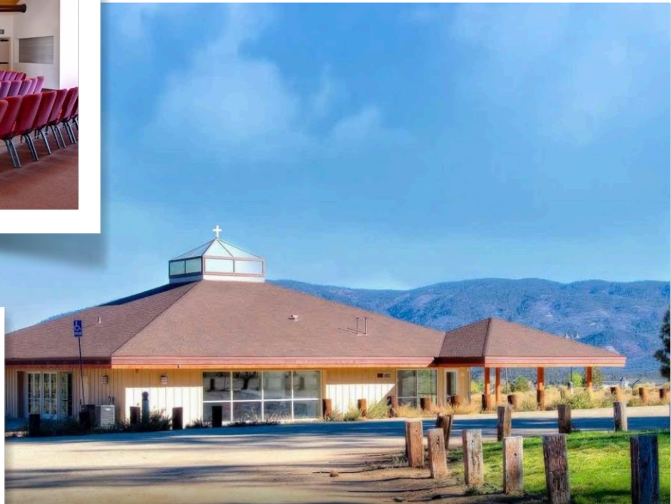

F.A.Q. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When is the Summer Youth Camp?

The Summer Youth Camp will be from June 20th to the 24th.

2. How will my teenager get up to the camp site on Monday?

Nathan Kang & another designated/approved driver will be driving up to the camp site with the teenagers on Monday at 12pm. We will be driving back to Eastvale on Friday around 12pm. The location to pick up your teenager is Vandermolen Elementary.

3. Will there be food provided during the camp?

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner will be provided for each teenager. Teens can bring outside snacks on their trip but must keep them in secured bags.

4. Does the camp have Wi-Fi?

*The camp location does **NOT** have any available WiFi for students.*

5. What should my teenager bring?

Bible, a pen, summer clothes for 4 nights and 5 days, outerwear jacket, activity clothes, toiletries & bath articles, sandals for bath, some spending money for snacks & drinks, a soft heart, and a good attitude.

6. What should my teenager NOT bring?

Laptops, tablets, weapons (this includes small knives, survival kits, etc.) pranks, bad attitude, clothes with worldly or inappropriate wording or designs. Cellphones will be taken during the duration of the camp.

7. Is there a dress code for the camp?

- **Guys:** For activities, pants/jeans and modest tops, no tank tops allowed. For services, guys need to wear nice pants/khakis with a modest collared shirt.
- **Girls:** For activities, pants/jeans and modest tops, For services, girls need to wear knee-length skirts with a modest top.

8. What is the weather like for the camp?

We're looking hot and dry during the camp. Please have your teenagers dress accordingly.

9. Are there any wild animals around the camp site?

Please keep in mind that there are wild animals such as bears, coyotes, and mountain lions within the mountain range of this camp site. It is an open range area and there will be an important and strict rule for each camper to never be alone in any circumstance.
